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INITIAL TEACHER LICENSURE

PROFESSIONAL TEACHER LICENSURE WITH MEd

MCLA's Initial teacher licensure programs prepare individuals to teach in their own classrooms, promote educational excellence and equity, deliver effective instruction, and encourage active participation in a democratic society. All initial licensure programs are approved by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Master of Education (MEd) pathways are available for those who have already earned an Initial teaching license and are looking to attain a Master's degree to advance their teaching license to Professional status.

INDIVIDUALIZED PLAN OF STUDY (NON-LICENSURE) WITH MEd

Students who do not seek teacher licensure may choose to advance their credentials through the Master of Education (MEd) degree at MCLA.

An individual area of concentration is developed by the student in consultation with the Education Department. Students select learning experiences that are congruent with their developing needs and interests.

4+I PROGRAM

The 4+I (Bachelors/Master of Education) Program is designed as an accelerated pathway for those students who seek to earn a teaching license and undergraduate degree, a second Initial license in Moderate Disabilities and a Master of Education (MEd).

Students in this program will first complete all the requirements for one or more undergraduate degrees, as well as requirements for an Initial teaching license in one of twelve undergraduate licensure programs. In the fifth year, including summers, students will complete the 33 graduate credits necessary to earn a Master of Education (MEd) and add a second Initial license in Moderate Disabilities.
